Try that in a court a law. Try telling a judge "Judge, a raped that women because this is the way that I was created". The judge isn't going to listen to you for a second. The judge isn't even going to bring that into the context of what you're talking about. You are responsible morally for your crime. We can try and blame God just like when Adam sinned against God, he said, "The women you gave me to me, she made me do it." We tend to pass the blame on to other people and even blame God for creating us. But what you've got to realize is that you live in a fallen creation. God made man perfect; man sinned against God, as by the sin of one man death came to all men. That is why we have sin and death because we have sinned against God. So, what you've got to do is say "Lord, I'm to blame, I've lusted, I've lied, I've stolen, I've blasphemed, You gave me life and I haven't loved you with heart, mind, soul, and strength. I take the blame for my sins. You're right, I'm wrong. Please forgive me." That is the beginning of getting right with God when you acknowledge the truth and you take the blame.

Something else to think about is each of us have a conscience. Conscience means "with knowledge". So every time you've done wrong, there has been that inner voice in the courtroom of the mind telling you what you are doing is wrong. It doesn't join in on your sins.
