Answer: You can measure the authenticity of a book within antiquity by looking at a couple of things: How many copies of the original are there? And how long after the original was written do we have a manuscript? For example...Do you believe that Julius Caesar existed? He wrote an account of the Gallic Wars. We don't have a manuscript of the original until after 1,000 years after it happened. So we have a lapse of 1,000 years and we only have 5 copies. And people consider this book to be extremely historically accurate. Nevertheless people believe that he existed and that he led his army according to the writings. Now let me tell you about the New Testament. Guess how many manuscripts of the New Testament that we have? Over 5,000 transcripts of the New Testament within 100 years on the events. Do you see the difference?
