### Contacting Bradfield School by Telephone

We have recently had a number of complaints regarding our telephone message when trying to contact the school.

Below is how the message system works:-

If you know the extension number of the person you are calling **PRESS 9** followed by the extension number. For example **9** followed by **223** will put you through to reception. Alternatively you can use the direct numbers as follows:-

- Dial **1** to report a **Student Absence**
- Dial **2** **Attendance & Behaviour**
- Dial **3** **Admissions & Examinations**
- Dial **4** **Finance**
- Dial **5** **Caretaking & Premises**
- Dial **6** to report a **Staff Absence**
- Dial **0** **All Other Enquiries (Reception)**

If you miss the department you want the message is on a loop and will repeat until you press the number you require.
