

## FOUR KEYS TO REVIVAL

### Key 1: Humility 2 Chronicles 7:11-15

*“...if my people, who are called by name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land...” - 2 Chron. 7:14*

*“Repent then and turn to God so that your sins may be wiped out and times of refreshing may come from the Lord...” – Acts 3:19*

#### 1. Humility Is \_\_\_\_\_

- God cannot fill people with the Spirit if they are already full of themselves. Too many believers don't think they need more of God!
- King Manasseh – 2 Chron. 33:10-13
- Seeking humility means we openly and willingly confess our sins and weaknesses as well as our need for God's intervention
- Joel 2:12-13, “...Rend your heart and not your garments...”

#### 2. Humility Is \_\_\_\_\_

- Psalm 35:13, “I put on sackcloth and humbled myself with fasting.”
- Ezra 8:21, “...I proclaimed a fast, so that we might humble ourselves before our God and ask him for a safe journey...”
- Fasting in the early church - Acts 13:2 and Acts 14:23
- Psalm 69:10-13, “When I weep and fast, I must endure scorn...”

#### 3. Humility Is \_\_\_\_\_

- How can we expect God to send revival when we cherish sin in our hearts and do nothing about it?
- Psalm 66:18, “If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened.”
- We need a Pentecost experience, just like the early church!
- Revival Fact: Long term it is glorious, short term it is painful!
