

LET'S CHASE SOME CHARIOTS

Acts 8:26-40

Have you ever stopped to think that your disappointments might actually be divine appointments?

Divine appointments are those times when God's providential guidance arranges lives to intersect at crucial moments and exact timing for encouragement and even salvation.

THREE THOUGHTS ON DIVINE APPOINTMENTS:

First, Divine Appointments Don't Always _____

- Philip had just preached a citywide crusade in Samaria... hundreds had come to Christ. You would think that he should stay and keep working!
- Verse 26, "Go south to the road – the desert road – that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza."
- Has God ever asked you to do something that you didn't think made sense?

Second, Divine Appointments Show Us _____

- Verse 27, "So he started out, and on his way he met an Ethiopian eunuch..."
- Verse 29, "Go to that chariot and stay near it."
- God cares about everyone and He wants to use us to reach them... including people we think we have nothing in common with.
- God had a major leader in the church, leave Samaria where hundreds of people were getting saved, to go to the middle of an isolated desert road to bring one man from another country into the Kingdom of God.

Third, Divine Appointments Require _____

- Had Philip hesitated even an hour, he would have missed his divine appointment.
- The key to being an effective witness for Christ isn't boldness it's obedience!
- Through obedience the Spirit will guide and empower us with boldness.
