1. Revival Prayer Is Characterized _____

- Jonah 3:5, “The Ninevites believed God. They declared a fast, and all of them, from the greatest to the least, put on sackcloth.”
- God will visit us when we reach a point of desperation.
- Psalm 51:16-17, “...The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit...”
- Are you satisfied or do you want more of God?

2. Revival Prayer Is Characterized _____

- Jonah 3:8b, “Let everyone call urgently on God.”
- Jeremiah 29:11-13, “...You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.”
- 1 Thess. 5:17, “Pray without ceasing.” Or “Pray continually”
- Jacob said, “I will not let you go unless you bless me.” Gen. 32:26

3. Revival Prayer Is Characterized _____

- Jonah 3:8c, “...I want you to give up your evil ways.”
- Isaiah 55:6-7, “Seek the Lord while he may be found; call on him while he is near. Let the wicked forsake his ways and the evil man his thoughts. Let him turn to the Lord, and he will have mercy on him for he will freely pardon.”
- Romans 6:22-23, “...you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness...”
- 1 Timothy 2:8, “...lift up holy hands in prayer.”
