

## FOUR KEYS TO REVIVAL

### Key 4: Repentance

#### 2 Chronicles 7:11-15

“...if my people, who are called by name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land...” - 2 Chron. 7:14

“Will you steal and murder, commit adultery and perjury, burn incense to Baal and follow other gods you have not known, and then come and stand before me in this house which bears my Name, and say “We are safe” “...do not plead with me, for I will not listen to you.” Jeremiah. 7:1-16

#### THREE THINGS WE MUST ABANDON:

##### 1. We Must Abandon \_\_\_\_\_ and Seek \_\_\_\_\_

- Judges 17:6 and 21:25, “In those days Israel had no king: everyone did as he saw fit.”
- Everyone wants to be his or her own king... instead of a humble servant of Christ.
- 2 Kings 5 tells the story of Naaman and his selfish pride.
- Revival is not like Burger King; you cannot have it your way!

##### 2. We Must Abandon \_\_\_\_\_ and Seek \_\_\_\_\_

- This form of wickedness can be summed up with one word: gluttony.
- Gluttony involves more than just overeating and getting drunk. It also describes the sinful excess of anything of this world.
- Ecclesiastes 5:10, “...whoever loves wealth is never satisfied...”
- Philippians 4:12, “...I have learned the secret of being content...”

##### 3. We Must Abandon \_\_\_\_\_ and Seek \_\_\_\_\_

- Romans 3:23, “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”
- You won’t drown if you fall in. You’ll drown if you stay under!
- Jeremiah 35:15; Hebrews 6:1; 1 John 2:1-6
- You’re called to a blameless life, not a perfect performance.
