1. Seeking the _____

- Exodus 33:12-14
- We were created to spend time in the Presence of God.
- Because of sin God removed His Presence from the Israelite camp.
- Developing an intimate relationship with God takes time and effort.
- Rest and refreshing naturally result in the Presence of God.

2. Seeking the _____

- Exodus 33:15-17
- God’s Presence is connected to His approval of His people.
- Sin creates a barrier between God’s Presence and us.
- Hebrews 12:14, “...without holiness no one will see the Lord.”
- We please him through: loving Him, believing in Him, obeying Him.

3. Seeking the _____

- Exodus 33:18-23
- Moses wanted to see God for all that He is.
- The only thing Moses didn’t get to see was God’s face.
- Yet, through Christ, the temple veil was torn in two!
- Through Christ we can once again see the face of God.
