TWO THINGS TO CONSIDER ABOUT JESUS' BETRAYERS:

1. Two Different _____

- Judas – faithful follower and treasurer
 - How could he go from trusted to betrayer?
 - It's most probable that Judas begun to get disillusioned.
 - This is played out every day when people get disillusioned with God.
- Peter – faithful follower and one of the three closest to Jesus
 - How could he go from “You can count on me!!!” to denying Christ to a little slave girl?
 - It's most probable that Peter's fears got the best of him.
 - This is played out every day when people won't stand up for Christ.

2. Two Possible _____

- Both of their actions led these men to a place of remorse and despair.
- What do you do when you do the very thing you said you would never do?
- You can either: (a) return to Him; (b) give up
- “Whatever you have done, whatever you have become, it doesn't matter. Please come home.” – *No Wonder They Call Him The Savior*, Max Lucado
- Mark 16:7, “...go, tell his disciples **and Peter**...”
