“My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will.” – Verse 39b

#### TWO THOUGHTS ABOUT CHRIST IN THE GARDEN:

##### 1. The Reason For The \_\_\_\_\_

- The clock was ticking and Jesus knew all that He was about to face
- Jesus was not just another martyr
- Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world
- This was the highest sorrow on the worst night of His life
- “If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me...”
- Can you relate? Have you been there? What was your worst night?

##### 2. The Example \_\_\_\_\_

- Christ opened up His heart and poured it out before God
- In His time of sorrow He had to connect with the Father
- Jesus didn't pray this prayer once. He kept on praying it.
- Sometimes we are less than honest with God
- Jesus was open, honest, and faithful
- “Yet not as I will, but as you will.”
- In many ways the victory of the cross was won at Gethsemane
