

THE IMPACT OF PENTECOST

Acts 2:1-12

“It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.” John 16:7

- There is a difference between initial and entire sanctification.

John 20:20-22

Acts 8:14-17, “...When they arrived, they prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit, because the Holy Spirit had not yet come upon any of them; they had simply been baptized into the name of the Lord Jesus...”

Acts 10:23-48; Acts 19

Many believers have been to Calvary for repentance, but have not been to Pentecost for purification and equipping.

THREE THINGS THE HOLY SPIRIT ENABLES US TO DO:

1. The Holy Spirit Enables Us To _____

- Romans 8:5-10, “...those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires...”
- 2 Peter 1:3-4, “His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness... through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.”

2. The Holy Spirit Enables Us To _____

- Acts 2:44-45, “All the believers had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need.”
- Acts 4:32-37, “All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of his possessions was his own...”

3. The Holy Spirit Enables Us To _____

- Acts 1:8, “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses...”
- Acts 2:40-41, “...Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.”
