- We are to be good stewards of our time, talents, finances, and relationships.

- Don't confuse hospitality with entertaining.
- 3 John 7-8, "It was for the sake of the Name that they went out, receiving no help from pagans. We ought therefore to show hospitality to such men so that we may work together for the truth."
- Hospitality comes from the same root word as "hospital" and "hospice"

2. Commit To A _____

- Devoted = "to give all or a large part of one's time or resources to a person, activity, or cause"
