2 REASONS WHY YOU SHOULD REGULARLY GO TO CHURCH

1. THROUGH CORPORATE WORSHIP _____

Hebrews 10:22-25, “...let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith... And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another...”

It’s a tragedy when any of our brothers or sisters in Christ drops out of church. Dropping out of church is not like dropping out of a club. It’s more like throwing away a precious treasure or gift.

Hebrews 12:16-17 reminds us of Esau who threw away his precious inheritance for a bowl of stew in Genesis 25.

We need to make sure that no one else makes the same mistake.

1 Corinthians 12:12-27, “The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body... But God has combined the members of the body... that it’s parts should have equal concern for each other...”

2. THROUGH CORPORATE WORSHIP _____

Hebrews 12:18-19, “You have not come to a mountain that can be touched and that is burning with fire...”

If we experienced what they experienced, do you think we would wonder about the importance of regular worship?
