\* The French player rolls 2D6 at the end of every turn beginning on Turn 4. On a roll of 8+, these come on the board from the direction of Dettingen along with the rest of the fleeing rabble. They have managed to maintain both order and some small vestige of dignity. They are under orders to proceed to Seligenstadt, but once either battalion is in base-to base contact with the **Marquis de Sangfroid**, the regiment will join the fight. However, this regiment is already exhausted from its exertions earlier this day, and will fight with a -1 modifier for morale.
