

## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

### **FIRE FIGHTER**

#### **GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES**

Shall work in the assigned station, training for and performing fire suppression and rescue duties.

1. They shall attend and actively participate in training sessions in accordance with the Training Officer and shall satisfactorily complete all required training in order to remain a member of the Department.
2. While at the station, firefighters shall perform their duties under the direct supervision of the senior officer/member present.
3. They shall become thoroughly familiar with rules, regulations, policies, procedures and orders of the Department.
4. They shall participate in weekly work details, including but not limited to, vehicle and equipment inspections, cleaning and maintaining of the station.
5. All firefighters must know how to drive Department vehicles.
6. They shall perform such other duties as prescribed by their superior officers.

#### **EMERGENCY SCENE OPERATIONS**

1. They shall promptly respond to all alarms or other emergencies.
2. They shall wear all Personal Protective Equipment issued to them for the appropriate incident.
3. When not immediately ordered to work at fires or other emergencies, they shall remain by the apparatus unless ordered differently by the officer in charge.
4. Shall not be actively engaged in interior structural fire fighting until completion of MFFTC Fire Fighter I training course.
5. Shall conduct such activities as directing hose lines, interior attacks, ventilation of buildings, search and rescue of buildings, operates extrication equipment, and any other required tasks, as their training and education dictates.
6. At fires and other emergencies, they shall be subject to orders of the Incident Commander or other officers operating under the direction of the Incident Commander.
7. They shall assist one another when executing the orders of superior officers.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

Must complete CAFD Rookie Training

Must complete MFFTC Fire Fighter I Training within one year of joining the Department.

Must complete MFFTC Fire Fighter II Training within two years of joining the Department.

Must participate in all on-going training.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

Must be a graduate of an accredited high school, or be in possession of a GED certificate.

Must be able to read and write sufficiently to prepare accurately written reports and records.

Must be a resident of the City of Clio, Vienna Twp., or Thetford Twp.

Must be available to answer 50% or more of the alarms on their assigned shift.

Must possess a valid operator's license issued by the State of Michigan.

Must be in good health, able to pass a physical examination including drug test, by a physician appointed and paid by the Fire Authority Board.

Must have the ability to meet the physical requirements of the position.
