This game will be composed of 23 rounds, each representing a student in Beryllium, including Ken (Tan Zi Jie), excluding the Eager Learners, Pau (the host), Jon (technical support \m/) and MICAH (to prevent game fixing).

At the start of each round, a random student (BRep) will be called to the “hot seat”. The BRep will be asked to whisper to Pau which Eager Learner he/she wishes to challenge. An eager learner can only be called once during a five-round set, except for Lance, who can be called for consecutive rounds. As Pau announces who is being challenged, the “spotlight” will be flashed upon the Eager Learner. One flag will be given to each of them. The question will be projected and read once. The first person to raise the flag will be given the chance to answer.

If the **Eager Learner** gets the chance and answers correctly, one point* will be awarded to their team, but if the Eager Learner gives the wrong answer, the BRep will be given a chance to steal and answer the question on his/her own once. If the BRep gives the wrong answer, the question will be considered void and another question** will be asked.

If the **BRep** gets the chance and answers correctly, one point* will be awarded to Beryllium, but if he/she gives the wrong answer, he/she will be asked if the “Cheat option” will be used or not. If not, the Eager Learner will be given a chance to steal and answer the question. If the Eager Learner gives the wrong answer, the question will be considered void and another question** will be asked.

*When Lance is the Eager Learner for the round, two points will be awarded instead of one.

**Per round, a maximum of two questions can only be asked. If nobody gets the point for the second question, a new BRep will be called for the next round.

Cheat option – this is where Micah Manalo comes to play. There will only be four chances to cheat for the class. When the cheat option is used, Micah will have 15 seconds to roam around the room and do his thing. He will then proceed to the tablet to write his answer. Whatever answer Micah gives, this will be the answer of the BRep for the question. Per round, the cheat option can only be used once. If Micah gives the wrong answer, the question will be considered void.

THE WINNER IS THE TEAM THAT GETS THE MOST NUMBER OF POINTS AFTER THE 23 ROUNDS OR WHEN THE TIME IS UP.
