The Page's have been making the most of the settled weather regularly returning with limits of nice snapper.

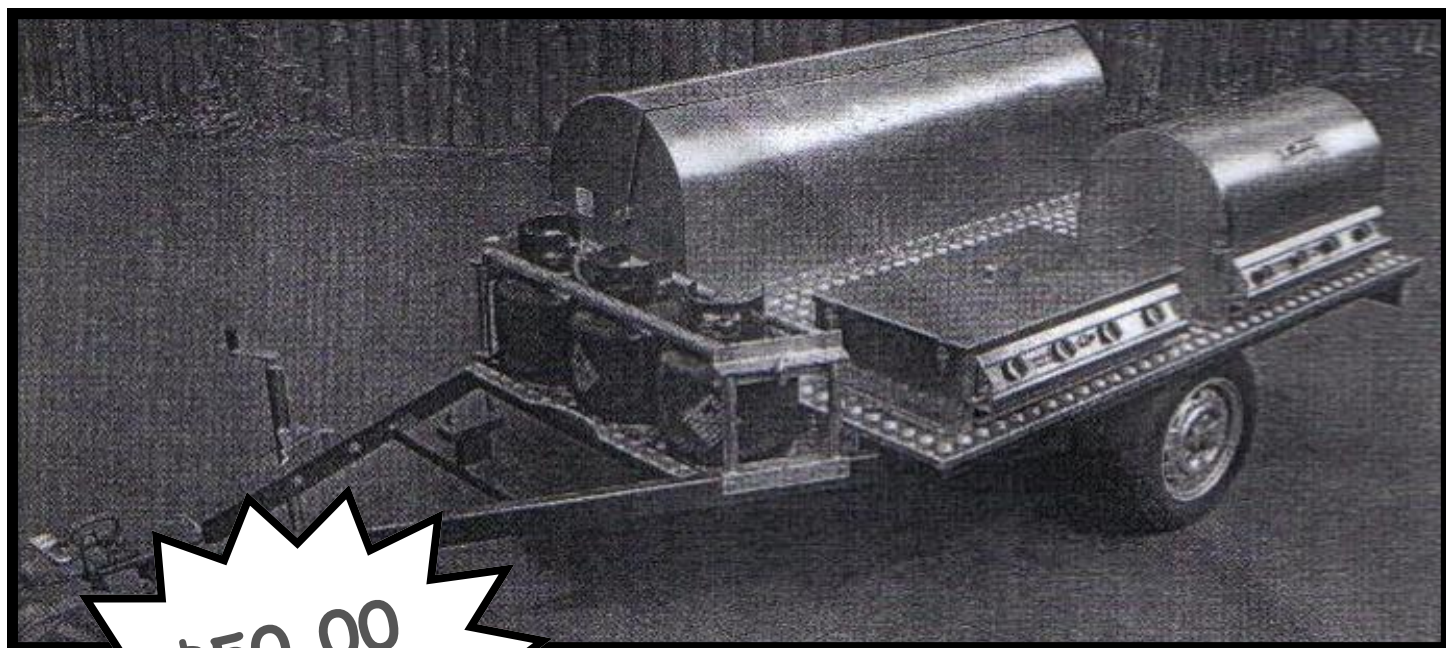
