President's Report

Okay, we're back on the ball again this month and everything goes to plan you'll be reading this earlier than usual.

As far as fishing is concerned, if you're not catching anything at the moment I'd say it's because you don't have a line in the water. The West coast is going off, the Hauraki Gulf is going off, there's good kingies being caught around Mayor Island and off Tairua. The Raglan Sport Fishing Clubs Icebreaker tournament start was delayed by a day, but those who did fish all three days of labour weekend did very well. I haven't seen the actual results, but have heard that if you were weighing a snapper exceeding 10 Kgs then you weren't even in the hunt.

With any luck the Gulf will continue to pump at least until after our Shelley Beach Family weekend. Hopefully you have your crews and accommodation sorted by now. If you're short of one or two hands for your crew or need accommodation then let Leandre know, there's quite a number of people who don't have access to boats who'd love a chance to get out see what this event really has to offer. We have booked out the Shelley beach campground and Leandre is co-ordinating room allocations so give her a yell if you want to come. Some of us will fish the Friday as well. Don't forget it's an open competition and we have we've invited the members of Raglan Sport Fishing club, the Dinsdale Club and your welcome to bring your mates as an introduction to the club (non member entry fee is only \$20). We can arrange to drop you off on some rocks if you're a keen rock fisho.

If you haven't paid your membership by now you'll probably be refused entry to enter, eat and drink at any other Sport Fishing Club in New Zealand, or get free courtesy weighs at any other affiliated Sport Fishing Club throughout the country, or participate in the competitions of affiliated clubs. Don't forget once you get your current membership card, make sure you always have it with you. Clubs are entitled to deny you access to courtesy weighs, or any of their club services if you can't provide proof of affiliation. With Christmas looming at an alarming pace, don't be caught short without a current membership card before travelling to your holiday destination.

The November club night will be held on November 16th, It's our second ever Buy Sell and swap night. So come down with anything that's taking up space in the garage or boat and see if you can shift it. We don't charge table fees or any other form of success fee, the only thing we want out of it is for everybody to turn up!

Our Final Act for the year will be our end of Year Christmas night. **See the calendar in this issue for more information.**

You should see One Base Entry forms pop up around the local boat and tackle shops about the end of November. Get those dates on your calendars and get your entry for in early. Don't forget we raffle of one adult entry at each of the two club nights before Christmas, for \$2 a ticket.....Why wouldn't you....?

We're extremely fortunate to still have all our major sponsors still with us, but if you know of anybody that is keen to be a sponsor, then please hook us up. There was quite a lot of talk after last year's tournament that there were new Sponsors keen to come on board. But did we write those contact details down? No!

You'll be contacted by a committee member over the next few weeks with a few questions about what you think about the club and what you'd like to see more of along with what you think we should stop doing. It's all part of the strategic plan we're putting together.

Finally much is being said and discussed about the proposed replacement of the sea bed a foreshore act. In essence, the proposed act puts the land currently owned and controlled by the government in the hands of it's customary owners. They are not allowed to restrict access to the beach and foreshore unless they specifically apply to the government to do so. The Act party, quite rightfully has had a line specifically added to ensure that the customary owners are specifically forbidden to charge for access. It's not as if these groups don't have a history of charging for or restricting access, e.g. Karikari Peninsula and School House bay in Tekaha just to name a couple.

The essence of the issue is, that when a block of land is owned by a tribe they are not entitled to the property rights that an individual is. i.e. large tracts of NZ coastal land are owned by farmers and private property owners, and yes access to the beaches and foreshore is indeed restricted to a privileged few.

So the quandary becomes:

1. Does the government rescind the private property right of the private owners of beach-front land(s) to create an equal playing field with the Maori tribal owners who will be forbidden from having the same rights to "their" property?
2. Allow the Maori tribal owners to exercise private property rights currently enjoyed by other beach side property owners?

Keep the status quo, and ensure access to these areas is freely allowable to all new Zealanders.

I personally am against any situation where an organisation who does not have a mandate to act in the interests of all New Zealanders', having control over such a cherished resource. If we are forced to accept a situation where that body is given those ownership rights then private property rights need to be excluded such that the resource continues to be freely available for all New Zealanders.

What do you need to do?

1. Download a copy of the proposed bill. This is the baseline, read it and make sure you understand, it, most of what you need to know is in the first few of sections.
2. Take a read of some of the commentaries and compare their opinions with what you've seen from reading the bill itself.

Ignore bar room discussions. Very few of these are based on facts, usually they're emotive and assume worst case scenarios that aren't even proposed in the bill.

Form and opinion about what you want and send a letter or email to your local MP.

Right that's it for now, hopefully we'll see you at the Shelley Beach comp, and or the next club night.

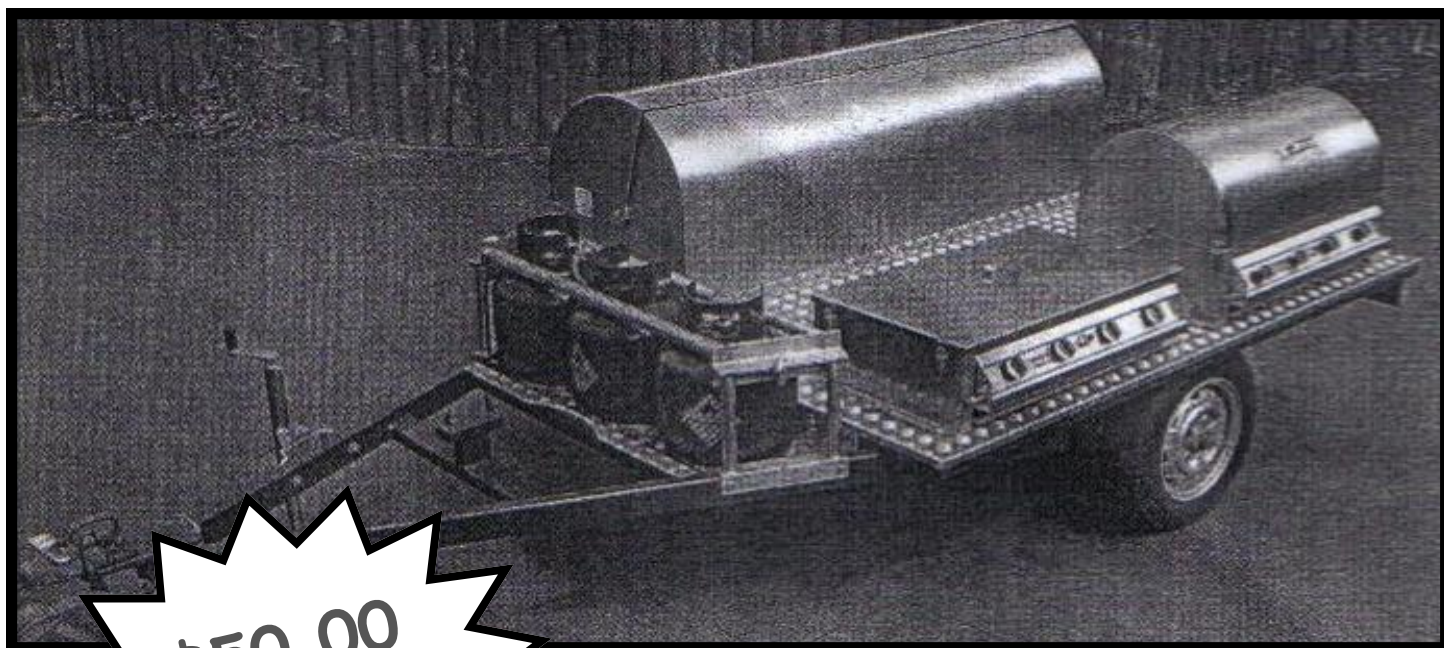
