President's Report

The first month of the new Club year has come and gone and it would seem that activity has been frantic for the new committee. So far we have;

1. Completely cleaned out the committee meeting room so it actually looks like a meeting room now,
2. Set the activity plan for the next 12 months,
3. Built a weighing gantry for the new Inland weigh station at Fish City,
4. Confirmed the dates of the Raglan One base for February 18,19 & 20.

Contacted all our sponsors to see what they can do to help us for the next 12 months.

The activity plan is shown below, note we have included all the new double points weekends along with a new Family weekend to be held at an east coast venue to be confirmed for March. You'll also notice that the Club Christmas party will be at the clubrooms this year on a normal club night.

We have arranged with Ross and the Fish City team to allow us to set up a weighing gantry at Fish City Kahikatea Drive. This facility will be available 7 days a week and also out of hours by arrangement, so if you're returning to town from anywhere in the country with Fish to weigh you'll be able to call in at Fish city and have it weighed for the club on Certified Scales. Thanks to Ross and the team for allowing this to happen, and also to Mark Olsen for making it happen. The next step will be to secure a catch board for the new weigh station. For the Sign writers out there, we're looking for sponsorship. i.e. if you'd be happy to provide a catch board then put your name on it. Similarly we also need a new set of Load cell type scales for the weigh station, so if you know anybody in the industry who can do us a deal then let us know.

You might think the dates of the one base had already been announced and set, well they had but..... At our first meeting a suggestion was made to move the dates to later in March to take advantage of usually, better Weather and Fishing. Once the suggestion was made we all sat there and thought that was a great point so we spent some time considering whether we could do it for next year. After much discussion we decided it was too much to do to try and move the dates for next year but it is definitely something we'll do for 2011. If you have any clear preferences for what you'd prefer as far as timing is concerned then let us have your feedback so we can take it into consideration. Obviously the two biggest considerations are Tides and Other tournaments out of Raglan and also West Coast Ports but there is always something else.

It's been a tough year for everybody, and certainly our sponsors, we ask a lot from our sponsors and we also know that this year their expenditure will most likely be limited, so we've decided to write to our sponsors and find out what they'll be able to offer this year and where they'd like that expenditure targeted. We're hoping that this will allow our sponsors to target their spending into areas where they feel they'll get the most benefit.

The winter challenge has been trucking along so far only a few fish have been weighed, and there's still time to get out there and get some fish weighed.

Don't forget the Coromandel weekend is coming up on November 13, 14 and 15th, at Shelley Beach campground, if you haven't made your booking yet then make sure you give them a call ASAP. This is always a great weekend to get to know the rest of the club and fishing can be very exciting.

As I write, we are trying to see if we can put together a display stand at the upcoming Boat show at Mystery Creek. We have found out that Clubs can exhibit at this event free of charge so it could be a great opportunity to let the greater Waikato, and New Zealand know that we're around and pick up some new members. The weekend is 16,17 & 18 and we need to know if people are available for $\frac{1}{2}$ day tours of duty to man the stand. It's short notice but it would be great exposure if we can get something organised. **Please contact myself or Leandre if you can make your self available for $\frac{1}{2}$ day over this period.**

Finally, Stu Ross and I attended the NZ Big Game Fishing Council AGM last weekend at Hokianga. The locals had done an absolutely splendid job of organising this event right down to Smoked Marlin and Snapper pate's and dips be available every night as part of pre diner drinks. The AGM itself was pretty straight forward, the one big piece of news is that the delegates voted to change the name of the council to the New Zealand Sport Fishing Council. I'm personally happy with this change as it is more representative of what the affiliated clubs actually do, and it gets away from the elitist stigma of "Big Game fishing" and the imagery of gin swilling fat people of luxurious launches. (not that there's anything wrong with gin swilling fat people of course!) The rest of the time was spent discussing two reviews of the marlin and Bluefin tuna tagging programmes along with a presentation from the Minister of Fisheries, Phil Heatley.

Don't forget we have our Buy, Sell and Swap night on Tuesday October 20th, combined with Prize giving for the Winter Challenge.

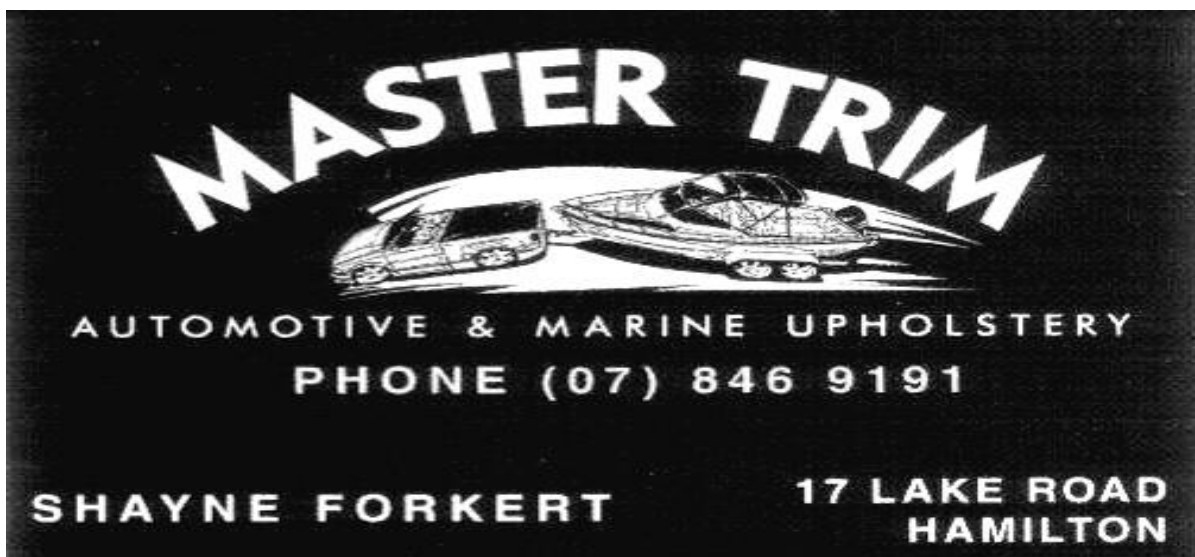
