2nd CLASS DRILL



Test Criteria:

I. Attire (10%)

All cadets must be in their Full No. 3 Uniform.

Uniform will be assessed by the following factors:

- a. Full Uniform worn correctly.
- b. Beret seasoned.
- c. No creases found on the uniform.
- d. Distinct iron lines on blouse and pants.
- e. Accurate placement of name tag, badges and buttons.
- f. Boots polished
- g. Hair – short and tidy (Boys) / tied up neatly and covered with hair net (Girls)

II. Practical Test - Drills (45%)

Cadets are needed to show proficiency in their 2nd Class Drill syllabus (Refer to Appendix A). 3rd Class Badge syllabus can be distributed to cadets before test.

Marks will be awarded in 3 grades.

Each drill will have a weightage of 3% of the overall assessment.

Poor	1
Fair	2
Good	3

Each examiner will grade on their observations. The total results will be added up and divided by 2 at the end of the test.

III. Drill Method of Instruction (45%)

Cadets shall be divided into different groups of 5 (depending on total strength) to take the test. They will be assigned to sets of commands before the exam date. Cadets are expected to plan and submit a proposal before test date.

A. Words of Command (10 %)

Cadets are to show good understanding of commands. Examiner may take the following factors into account.

- a. Ability to divide commands into 3 parts.
(Introductory, Cautionary, Execution)
- b. Loudness / Confidence level
- c. Pronunciation of command given

B. Crowd Management Skills (15 %)

Cadet must show good management skills in handling the audience. Examiner may take the following factors into account.

- a. Location
- b. Method of handling audience
- c. Attention getter

C. Presentation Skill (20 %)

Examiner may take the following factors into account.

- d. Verbal Communication
 - Confidence of speaker
 - Voice volume
- e. Non – Verbal Communication
 - Gestures/ Body Language
- f. Response to Questions
- g. Method of Conducting Lesson
(Flow of Lesson etc)
- h. Able to delivery correct information to audience

V. Recommended Test Procedures

Examiner may separate the cadets into 2 groups or groups of 12 – 20 depending on the total strength.

At least 2 examiners will be grading a group to ensure fairness.

Proposed time line as stated below:

Duration	Activity	Remarks
10 minutes	Uniform Inspection	Examiner may grade the bearing of the cadets.
45 minutes	Drills	Cadets are separated into groups and tested by 2 examiners per group.
15 minutes	Break	Cadets may practice and prepare for MOI.
1.5 hour	MOI	Cadets are to get into their groups for MOI. Examiner may call out cadets one by one for WOC while assessing on the drills of the squad.
