3rd CLASS DRILL



Test Criteria:

I. Attire (15%)

All cadets must be in their Full No. 3 Uniform.

Uniform will be assessed by the following factors:

- a. Full Uniform worn correctly.
- b. Beret seasoned.
- c. No creases found on the uniform.
- d. Distinct iron lines on blouse and pants.
- e. Accurate placement of name tag, badges and buttons.
- f. Boots polished
- g. Hair – short and tidy (Boys) / tied up neatly and covered with hair net (Girls)

II. Theory Test (15%)

Cadets are to sit for a 15 minutes paper to test on their knowledge on commands.
Refer to Appendix A for Test Paper.

III. Practical Test (60%)

Cadets are needed to show proficiency in their 3rd Class Drill syllabus (Refer to Appendix B). 3rd Class Badge syllabus can be distributed to cadets before test.

Marks will be awarded in 4 grades.

Each drill will have a weightage of 3% of the overall assessment.

Poor	1
Fair	2
Good	3
Very Good	4

4th grade will serve as a bonus for those who performed exceptionally well.

Refer to Appendix C for Score Sheet.

Each examiner will grade on their observations. The total results will be added up and divided by 2 at the end of the test.



IV. Words of Command (10%)

Cadets are to show good understanding of commands. Examiner may take the following factors into account.

- Ability to divide commands into 3 parts.
(Introductory, Cautionary, Execution)
- Loudness / Confidence level
- Pronunciation of command given

V. Test Summary

VI. Recommended Test Procedures

Examiner may separate the cadets into 2 groups or groups of 12 – 20 depending on the total strength.

At least 2 examiners will be grading a group to ensure fairness.

Proposed time line as stated below:

Duration	Activity	Remarks
20 minutes	Theory Test	Cadets are to be seated in a classroom separated from each other. Acts of cheating will be severely dealt with.
15 minutes	Break	Cadets may practice and prepare for Practical Test.
10 minutes	Uniform Inspection	Examiner may grade the bearing of the cadets.
1.5 hour	Practical Test	Cadets are to get into their groups for Practical Test. Examiner may call out cadets one by one for WOC while assessing on the drills of the squad.
